Instructions to Applicants

Essential Requirements for Applicants

Please carefully follow the guidelines below when preparing your Expression of Interest. Please prepare your document using 10 point type or larger on A4 paper, using MSWord and submit your application as a single document.

Please fill out **ALL** sections of the Expression of Interest application form.

Please ensure that for each Chief Investigator the following details are correctly supplied: Name, title, position, qualifications, address and contact details.

Please ensure that for each Associate Investigator the following details are correctly supplied: Name, title, email and institution.

NOTE 1: Applicants may only be named as a Chief Investigator on **one** application. Chief Investigators may be named as Associate Investigators on other applications.

NOTE 2: Funding is normally for one year but consideration will be given for a second year of funding for top ranked applications in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Foundation. In 2011 we will be offering Grants-in-Aid in the following three categories*:

1. General funding for research into leukaemias, lymphomas, myeloma and related blood disorders and;
2. CLL Research Initiative
3. CLL-8 Translational Health Care Initiative. (This initiative will NOT use the EOI process. Please go straight to the full CLL-8 application form provided on our website).

****You must indicate on the application form the funding category that you wish your application to be considered for - applications will only be considered for the funding category indicated.***

The following items should be prepared as described then inserted in the application form in the marked spaces. Please submit as a single document:

1. **Statement of relevance to the aims of the Leukaemia Foundation** (1800 characters max excluding spaces), outlining the relevance of the proposal to research into leukaemia, lymphoma, myeloma or related blood disorders and and to potential outcomes for patients and families living with these blood cancers and related disorders. Relevance will be highly regarded by the reviewers.

2. **Proposal outline** (5500 characters max excluding spaces) describing the major objectives of your proposal and the principal research methodologies to be employed.
3. **References** please keep to a minimum.
4. **Estimated budget** (500 characters max excluding spaces) showing the total amount only and a brief justification of proposed expenditure.
5. **A brief curriculum vitae** (4000 characters max excluding spaces) of the Chief Investigator(s) including their six most relevant publications.

The **closing date** for receipt of Expressions of Interest by the Foundation is **28 May 2010**.
