Ms Wilkes graduated from Curtin University in WA with a Bachelor of Pharmacy degree in 1986. She went on to complete her Post Graduate Diploma in Hospital Pharmacy in 1995, and in 1999 she successfully obtained Board Certification in Oncology Pharmacy (US).

Julie has worked in the area of oncology and haematology for the past 20 years, in a number of hospitals (both public and private) in Western Australia. In 2000, she was successful in obtaining a grant from the Health Department of WA to establish the Home Cancer Care Service, which enables oncology and haematology patients to receive their chemotherapy and supportive care therapy at home.

Currently she is employed at Royal Perth Hospital where she works as a clinical pharmacist specialising in haematology and as the Coordinator of the Home Cancer Care Service. Her interests include drug therapy of haematological malignancies, bone marrow transplantation and infectious complications in haematology patients.
